Montana has a history of poor workplace safety. In comparison to our neighboring states our workers are more likely to be injured. The costs of such a tradition are debilitating. In response to this demand for greater emphasis on safety in the workplace WorkSafeMT was formed. The WorkSafeMT Foundation is a nonprofit partnership that includes state and federal agencies, private business, labor unions, organizations and Montana citizens. Their goal is to raise awareness of Montana's poor safety performance and engage employers and employees in changing it.
