

WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE WOMEN'S HEALTH AND CANCER RIGHTS ACT OF 1998 (WHCRA) AS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW

If you have had or are going to have a mastectomy, you may be entitled to certain benefits under WHCRA. For individuals receiving mastectomy-related benefits, coverage will be provided in a manner determined in consultation with the attending physician and the patient, for:

1. All stages of reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed;
2. Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance after definitive reconstructive breast surgery on the diseased breast has been performed;
3. Chemotherapy;
4. Prostheses; and
5. Treatment of physical complications of the mastectomy, including lymphedemas.

These benefits will be provided subject to any deductible and copayment provisions of your health plan. For specific deductible and copayment information on your plan, please refer to your schedule of benefits.
